Hehas been the President of the International Society of Neuroimmunology, and he continues to co-direct itsAmericas and Global Schools of Neuroimmunology.Dr. Yong's research interests lie in the areaofneuroimmunology, neuroprotection and CNS regeneration, and his projects are guided by MS,glioblastomaand intracerebral hemorrhage. Hehas published 365peer-reviewed manuscripts and his research has been translated into Phase 2and 3clinical trials in MS; his teamhas an ongoing Phase 1/2atrial in glioblastoma. His work has been cited over 35,000 times (h-index of 105)accordingto GoogleScholar. Dr. Yong is an elected fellow of both the Canadian Academy of Health Sciencesand theRoyal Society of Canada. He receivedthe 2017 Allyn Taylor International Prize in Medicine for 'transformational discoveries in MS'. Dr. Yong was profiled in the August 2021 issue of the world's #1 clinical neurology journal, Lancet Neurology.
