Dr Pietro Annovazzi graduated in medicine in 2002 at Vita-Salute San Raffaele University in Milano, where he was a resident in Neurology until 2007. During his residency, he focused on Multiple Sclerosis diagnosis and treatment, and performed clinical research in such field, as well as in neurophysiology and collaborated with the headache and neuropathic pain unit.

In 2007 he moved to his current working place: Multiple Sclerosis Study Center in Gallarate Hospital. There he further specialised in clinical research in the field of demyelinating diseases, with a focus on biostatistics, publishing several papers on post-marketing safety and efficacy evaluation of drugs. He is also involved in studies in paediatric MS and studies evaluating the impact of pregnancy on inflammatory central nervous system diseases; he serves as the national coordinator for Italy of the Alemtuzumab and Teriflunomide pregnancy registry. He is member of the MS Study Group of the Italian Neurological Society, and is certified with ANIRCEF-ASC Master in diagnosis and management of Headaches.
