Submission criteria

As you prepare your submission, please review and make sure to meet the below abstract and poster submission criteria.

Two simple steps to submit your abstract:

1. Login and create your profile
2. Submit your abstract

Make sure to remember your password! You will need your email and password to access the abstract tool and submit your poster and poster recording.

Poster Session and Young Investigator Poster Award

- **Poster Session:**
The Scientific Committee will evaluate the submitted abstracts for acceptance. Authors of the selected best abstracts will be invited to present their research on stage on the 8th of February, 2025. **For virtual attendees, there will be an option to deliver the presentation remotely.**
- **Eligibility and Competition:**
Young investigators born in 1989 or later who submit an abstract will automatically be considered for the Young Investigator Award. Based on the **full poster**, the jury will make a selection of the best Young Investigator posters and the authors will be invited to present their research on stage on the 8th of February, 2025. **For virtual attendees, there will be an option to deliver the presentation remotely.**
- **Award and Recognition:**
The winner will be announced at the Young Investigator Award Winner session (timing to be confirmed) and will receive free registration, accommodation, and travel (with a maximum of 1500 €), to the Annual Meeting in Baveno, Italy, from November 13 to 15, 2025, with the theme “*Emerging Therapies.*”
Additionally, the winner will join the ECF Fellow Community, a dynamic international network of young investigators collaborating in the fields of MS, NMOSD, and MOGAD.

Abstract Submission Timeline

- **Submission Deadline:**
All abstracts must be submitted electronically in PDF format by Wednesday, the **15th of January, 2025, at 11:59 PM CET**. Young Investigators need to upload their full poster by the **15th of January 2025, at 11:59 PM CET**. Other participants can either bring their poster onsite or upload their poster by the **31st of January, 2025 at 11:59 PM CET**.
- **Review and Notification:**
A jury will review the abstracts and participants will be notified of the acceptance by **Tuesday the 24th of January, 2025**.
- **Event Dates:**
The digital poster exhibition will take place on the **7th and the 8th of February , 2025**, with oral presentations of the 10 selected top posters scheduled for the **8th of February, 2025** (see Programme: Oral Communications).

Abstract submission criteria

- All abstracts should be written in English.
- It is the author's responsibility to submit a fully finalized abstract. Any errors in spelling, grammar or scientific facts will be reproduced as typed by the author.
- At the time of submission, the material should not have been published or accepted for publication.
- Encore abstracts are accepted but not favored. In case of encore abstracts, the conference and conference date should be mentioned in the abstract. If the data include new data not presented before, the abstract will not be considered as encore.
- The title of the abstract should include all the words crucial for a subject index. (Min 55, max 83 characters, without spaces)
- In addition, a **short title of maximum 45 characters**, without spaces should be submitted.
- The body of the abstract should be limited to **maximum 300 words**, excluding title and abstract information of the authors. Tables are not accepted.

- The topic should deal with NMOSD/MOGAD and data should be scientifically qualified.
- If the abstract has more than one author, the main author should be clearly identified (e.g.: label: 'main author') and all co-authors should be clearly mentioned.
- The submitting author should be one of the main authors.
- The submitting author is presumed to be the presenter of the abstract accepted for presentation.
- We do not accept non-authors to present, only authors/co-authors.
- The submitting author confirms that all authors are aware of and agree to the content of the abstract and support the data presented.
- All correspondence concerning the abstract will be sent to the submitting author/co-author who is responsible for informing any other co-author(s) of the status of the abstract.
- The presenting author of an abstract must register for the congress by the given deadline for either the onsite or the online meeting (**Friday, January 31st 2025**). The Organising Committee reserves the right to exclude abstracts from the programme for which registration is not duly completed within the deadline advised.
- The curriculum vitae or at least a short CV of the submitting author should be included with the submission. The date of birth of the submitting author should be mentioned on the CV.
- Any possible conflicts of interest should be disclosed.
- Should you wish to make corrections to an abstract already submitted or if you wish to submit other abstracts later, you may use your personal access codes (email and password). Corrections to abstracts can only be made until **Tuesday, December 31st, 2024** (the deadline of abstract submission).



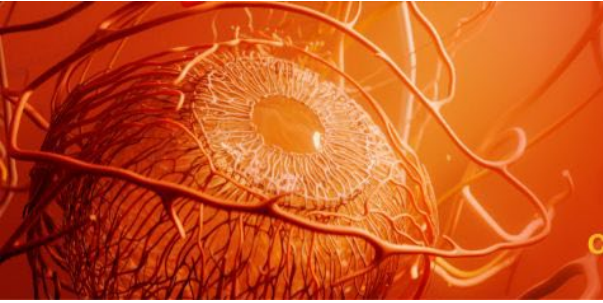
