The MS International Federation is funding research awards in the form of two-year fellowships (McDonald) and 3-6 month (Du Pré) travel grants, which are aimed exclusively to clinicians and researchers who work in and are from **low- and middle-income countries**, as defined by [the World Bank](#). Applicants will have at least post-graduate experience in MS.
